## NOTICE OF FORTHCOMING HIGHWAY AND LANDSCAPE IMPROVEMENT WORKS ON EALING ROAD AND VILLAGE GREEN

Dear Business Owner,

As part of Visions for Northolt, Ealing Council will be carrying out highway and landscape improvement works along Ealing Road, between the junction with Mandeville Road and 12 Ealing Road, and within the Village Green. The team has worked with local businesses, stakeholders and the community through an extensive engagement programme to address poor connectivity, congestion, road safety and air quality in Northolt. The works will bring benefits to all road users and enhance user experience across the town. The forthcoming programme of work includes:

- Widened and enhanced footways
- Improved paths through the Village Green
- New trees, planting and street furniture
- New crossings and improved heritage lighting
- Stop and Shop Plus parking scheme. These improvements will make travel in Northolt safer, easier and more pleasant for all, including cyclists and pedestrians. Ealing Council's term contractor will commence delivery of the scheme during the **w/c 27 November 2023 until April 2024**. Works will commence within the Village Green area and in the New Year move onto the shopping parade. If there are road closures or traffic management that prevents direct access as part of these works, you will receive additional notification ahead of time. Normal working hours are Monday to Friday 8am to 5pm and Saturday from 8am to 1pm, however there may be some works that take place outside of these hours. Please contact us if your property is having building work carried out requiring a new utility connection (gas, electric or water). We can assist with organising the connection before the new surface is laid to avoid damaging it.

We understand that works can be disruptive and cause noise disturbance, noise levels and disruption will be kept to a minimum. We thank you in advance for your cooperation and apologise for any inconvenience these works may cause.
