NOTICE OF FORTHCOMING HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT WORKS ON KENSINGTON ROAD AND EALING ROAD

Dear Resident

As part of Visions for Northolt, Ealing Council will be carrying out highway improvement works along Kensington Road and Ealing Road, between the junctions of Ruislip Road and Rowdell Road.

The programme of work includes:

• Pedestrian and cycle crossings

- Cycle tracks
- Narrowed junctions at side roads
- Footway renewal
- Planting and sustainable drainage
- Lighting and upgraded signage

These improvements will make travel in Northolt safer, easier and more pleasant for all, including cyclists and pedestrians as well as supporting active and sustainable travel, addressing concerns about pollution, traffic and road safety. Proposals have been co-designed with residents and businesses through an extensive engagement programme. Subject to statutory consultation, Ealing Council's term contractor will commence delivery of the scheme during the **w/c 7th August 2023 until January 2024**. Works will be carried out in sections to minimise disruption, with the first area of construction beginning near the junction of Westway Close. Subject to site constraints, works phasing may be varied to minimise delay. If there are road closures or traffic management that prevents direct access as part of these works, you will receive additional notification ahead of time. Normal working hours are Monday to Friday 8am to 5pm and Saturday from 8am to 1pm, however there may be some works that take place outside of these hours. Please contact us if your property is having building work carried out requiring a new utility connection (gas, electric or water). We can assist with organising the connection before the new surface is laid to avoid damaging it.

We understand that works can be disruptive and cause noise disturbance, therefore noise levels and disruption will be kept to a minimum. We thank you in advance for your cooperation and apologise for any inconvenience the works may cause.
