

NOTICE OF FORTHCOMING ONE WAY SYSTEM AND PARKING CHANGES – Village Green and Ealing Road Improvements (Visions for Northolt)

Dear Resident / Businesses / Vehicle Owner,

In consideration of upcoming infrastructure enhancements that will be taking place on the shopping parade on Ealing Road, Ealing Council are writing to inform you of a temporary one-way system and changes to parking which will be implemented to deliver the project safely.

Temporary One-Way System and Diversion Route:

To facilitate the highway improvement works, a temporary one-way system will be in place, allowing traffic to move only south through the shopping parade along Ealing Road. Northbound traffic along Ealing Road headed towards Mandeville Road will be diverted along Court Farm Road, Summit Road, Sandringham Road and Belvue Road. A plan showing this diversion is presented overleaf.

The one-way system will be in place from 15th January 2024 until 29th April 2024. Emergency access will not be affected at any time.

Parking Changes:

To deliver the improvements safely and successfully to the streetscape; the parking outside the shopping parade will be suspended. Removing all the spaces temporarily may be necessary to deliver the changes efficiently. Subject to site conditions, parking spaces may be made available outside the shops during the construction if safe to do so. Efforts will be made to limit the impact to the parking spaces.

To enable work to take place any vehicles parked in the working area or suspended bays will be relocated to a neighbouring street. They will NOT be returned to their original position once the works are complete.

Residents and business owners affected by the extent of works are strongly advised to park away from the work area to avoid delay and disruption.

The parking will be suspended from 15th January 2024 until 29th April 2024.
